paths on all par threes, and stay 50 metres back from all tees and greens. Please be mindful of the softer conditions.

Divot recovery slows down over the winter months so it is more important than ever to sand all fairway divots, there are now bucket refill stations on holes 3, 6 and 12, we have also added another 50 new buckets with a hooked handle which works better for those that walk the course.

After a late stolonising of our couch nursery, the plant material is slowly coming to life.


